Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra Performs *The Music of Queen* in Marsh *Symphony on the Prairie* Concerts June 29-30

Symphonic program pairs tribute rock band with ISO to perform hits by Rock 'n' Roll Legends Queen

INDIANAPOLIS – Conductor and composer Brent Havens and the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra will promise to “Rock You” at the Conner Prairie Amphitheater with a broad spectrum of popular favorites by the legendary 1970s and '80s Rock 'n' Roll band Queen in Marsh *Symphony on the Prairie* concerts Friday and Saturday, June 29 and 30, at 8 p.m.

Created by Maestro Havens, the program will feature a tribute band fronted by lead singer Brody Dolyniuk and the ISO performing many of Queen’s timeless hits including “I Want It All,” “Somebody to Love,” “Bohemian Rhapsody,” “Killer Queen,” “Crazy Little Thing Called Love,” “Fat Bottomed Girls,” “Another One Bites the Dust,” “We Will Rock You,” and “We Are the Champions,” among others. The ISO and Havens have collaborated on many occasions to perform his original symphonic creations, which have included the music of Led Zeppelin, Pink Floyd, Michael Jackson and Queen, the latter of which was last presented by the Orchestra in August 2009 at Marsh *Symphony on the Prairie*.

Tickets are priced at \$22 in advance and \$27 at the gate for adults, with children’s prices (ages 2-12) at \$11 in advance and \$13 at the gate. Tickets may be purchased at any Marsh, MainStreet or O’Malia’s supermarket location, by calling the Hilbert Circle Theatre Box Office at (317) 639-4300, toll free at (800) 366-8457, or by visiting the ISO’s website at www.IndianapolisSymphony.org. Premium Parking passes may be purchased for \$20 each exclusively through the Hilbert Circle Theatre Box Office.

Patrons can bring their own food, beverages (including alcohol) and blankets or lawn chairs to enjoy picnicking to the music on the beautiful natural grass amphitheater or reserve a table for only \$59 with seating for up to 10 people near the stage. With the exception of the limited Premium Parking spaces, all other parking is free.

If rain is possible on concert days, the public can stay up-to-date by listening to radio station WIBC (93.1 FM), the official station for Marsh *Symphony on the Prairie* weather and traffic, or through the ISO’s mSymphony weather text message service by texting WEATHER [date of performance] (e.g. WEATHER JUNE 29) to 24025. This service will be available on every concert date and will be updated by the ISO as conditions change.

Due to road construction projects on the northeast side of the Indianapolis metropolitan area, please “Know Before You Go” where construction projects are in progress and allow plenty of time to get to Conner Prairie for the concert. Patrons can listen to WIBC-FM for the latest traffic updates when en route to the concerts.

Artist Biographies:

Composer, arranger and conductor **Brent Havens** has written music for orchestras, feature films and virtually every kind of television programming, including movies for networks such as ABC, CBS and The Family Channel,

commercials, sports music for ESPN and cartoons. He is the creator of seven symphonic rock programs – *The Music of Led Zeppelin*, *The Music of Pink Floyd*, *The Music of the Doors*, *The Music of the Eagles*, *The Music of Queen*, *The Music of Michael Jackson* and most recently, *The Music of The Who* – and also completed the score for the film *Quo Vadis* for a Premier Plus remake of the classic 1956 gladiator film. In 2009, he collaborated with the Doobie Brothers and the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra by arranging songs for and conducting the group for Harley Davidson's 100th anniversary party that was attended by more than 150,000 people.

Vocalist **Brody Dolyniuk** is a gifted, natural-born musician who has earned an outstanding reputation in the entertainment industry for capturing the voices and mannerisms of classic performers from music (especially Rock 'n' Roll front men), television and films. Over the years he has performed the music from rock bands that inspired him by creating *Yellow Brick Road*, one of Las Vegas' most successful rock cover bands and he assumed the lead role in *Rock Show!*, in which he performs in character as many of rock's greatest lead singers. Over the years, Dolyniuk has made several radio and television appearances and earned a spot in the finals of two national singing competitions. In 2007, he performed several vocal tracks on the video game *Guitar hero III: Legends of Rock* and has done several more for the new Konami game *Rock Revolution*.
