Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra and Artists-in-Residence Time for Three Perform *Symphony Under the Stars* Concert August 5 at Wild Air Farms in Zionsville

Innovative program includes music by Coldplay, Grieg, and two original Time for Three works plus classical favorite “Summer” from Vivaldi’s The Four Seasons

INDIANAPOLIS – The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra’s string section and its Artists-in-Residence, string trio Time for Three, will perform a diverse and colorful outdoor concert titled *Symphony Under the Stars* on Sunday, August 5, at 8 p.m. at the picturesque Wild Air Farms, a family-owned ranch located at 7400 Hunt Club Road in Zionsville. Patrons are permitted to bring their own food and beverages to the concert, and limited concessions will be available for purchase on site. Gates open at 6 p.m.

The program pairing the ISO’s string section with Time for Three under the baton of Assistant Conductor David Glover will open with familiar and popular classical works that will include Felix Mendelssohn’s Sinfonia No. 10 for String Orchestra, George Gershwin’s shimmering *Lullaby for Strings*, “Summer” from Antonio Vivaldi’s *The Four Seasons* featuring ISO Concertmaster Zack De Pue as soloist and the Finale from Piotr Ilych Tchaikovsky’s *Serenade for Strings*. Following intermission, the Orchestra will perform selections from Edvard Grieg’s pastoral *Holberg Suite* that will be melded with Time for Three performing two original works titled *Banjo Love* and *Kissing in the Tree*, and the trio will close out the program with its own arrangement of British alternative rock band Coldplay’s “UFO” to bring the concert to a rousing conclusion.

General admission tickets are \$25 for adults and \$13 for those with a student ID and children 12 and under, with children two and under receiving free admission. Symphony Under the Stars is part of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra’s outreach effort to perform in communities throughout Indiana. Each season, the Indianapolis Symphony presents concerts in Wabash, Greencastle, Lebanon, Bloomington and in Indianapolis’ Ellenberger Park.

Artist Biographies:

David Glover was appointed Assistant Conductor of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra in 2011, a position in which he assists to cover all Lilly *Classical Series* concerts and leads the ISO’s *Young People’s Discovery*, *SymFUNy Sundays* and *Side-by-Side* concerts. He also is the creative leader and host of the ISO’s “Sound Off” interactive pre-concert lecture series. In past seasons he has conducted the ISO as well as the Ensemble Orchestral de Paris, North Czech Philharmonic, Bulgarian Opera, and the Bourgas and Hungarian Opera. Previous posts have included the Ansbacher Fellowship at the Salzburg Festival and he served as conductor of the Indiana University All-Campus Orchestra. In addition to his ISO duties, he serves as Artistic Director of the Wabash Valley Youth Symphony.

Founded in 2001 by three Curtis Institute of Music students, **Time for Three** is increasingly gaining attention as one of America’s brightest and most unique string ensembles by exploring repertoire that ranges from a mix of bluegrass, gypsy, jazz, country western fiddling, classical, improvisatory and original works and arrangements. The

trio has performed more than 200 engagements as diverse as its music by appearing as featured guest soloists with The Philadelphia Orchestra to opening for k.d. lang at Philadelphia's Kimmel Center. They have appeared at prestigious venues such as the Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum in Boston, the 92nd Street Y in New York and the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., among others. The trio features violinists Nick Kendall (2002 Young Concert Artists International Competition winner) and Zach De Pue (1998 Fischhoff Competition winner and ISO Concertmaster), and bassist Ranaan Meyer (noted jazz and classical bassist and composer).

In November 2009, Time for Three became the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra's first ensemble-in-residence and embarked on bringing its genre-bending musical style to Indianapolis and the greater community. Now in the final year of its residency, Time for Three has established relationships with two local high schools – Broad Ripple and Perry Meridian – in order to work with and inspire student musicians; developed programming for and has performed in the ISO's Stella Artois *Happy Hour at the Symphony*, *Symphonic Hits* powered by Lilly and Marsh *Symphony on the Prairie* series; and played in many venues outside of Hilbert Circle Theatre in order to attract new communities to symphonic music.
