Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra to eliminate 8-minute fireworks finale from *Star-Spangled Symphony* Concerts July 2-4 at Conner Prairie Amphitheater

Fireworks finale to be included in another concert during season if drought conditions improve

INDIANAPOLIS – Despite rainfall in the Town of Fishers over the weekend, the official ban on all professional pyrotechnic displays issued by the Fishers Fire Department remains in effect prompting the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra to exclude the 8-minute fireworks finale during the July 2-4 Marsh *Symphony on the Prairie* concerts for the safety of its patrons and the Conner Prairie property.

This will impact only the pyrotechnic portion of the concerts and will not affect the concert set list, artillery accompaniment to Tchaikovsky's *1812 Overture* or other artistic elements of the program.

If conditions improve in the near future, the ISO will include the fireworks display at the conclusion of another *Symphony on the Prairie* performance.
