**Acclaimed sister-duo Lily & Madeleine and MC Tony Styxx join Time for Three and the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra for Stella Artois *Happy Hour at the Symphony* Jan. 23**

INDIANAPOLIS – In its second installment of the season, the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra's Stella Artois *Happy Hour at the Symphony* program pays homage to Indiana's home grown talent with the orchestra debuts of Indie-folk artists and sisters, [Lily & Madeleine](#) and spoken word artist [Tony Styxx](#) alongside ISO artists-in-residence Time for Three and the Orchestra, Thursday, Jan. 23, 2014, at 6:30 p.m.

Born and raised in Indianapolis, the sisters (Lily, age 16 and Madeleine, age 19) originally gained notice when the acoustic video for their song "In the Middle" was featured on the homepage at Reddit. To date, the video has been viewed over 320,000 times. Lily and Madeleine's debut EP, *The Weight of the Globe*, was recorded in Bloomington, Indiana, and was released earlier this year to widespread acclaim. Their self-titled, full-length debut [Lily & Madeleine](#) is now out on Asthmatic Kitty Records. As noted by the *Chicago Tribune*, "Prepare to be emotionally disarmed by the otherworldly, heart-shredding harmonies of these Indianapolis, Ind. sisters."

Also hailing from Indianapolis, Tony Styxx describes his art as "spoken word/MC/human beat box" and has recently released his first album *Welcome to Life*. An entertainer since age 18, Tony now presents shows throughout the Midwest.

Stella Artois *Happy Hour at the Symphony* begins at 5 p.m. with a pre-concert, complimentary food sampling from many local restaurants and drink sponsors including Adobo Grill, Coca-Cola, Familia Camarena Tequila, Eddie Merlot's, Harry and Izzy's, Just Pop In!, Starbucks, Stella Artois and White Castle.
