Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra appoints Steve Hamilton as Vice President of Finance

INDIANAPOLIS – The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra announced today the appointment of Steve Hamilton as Vice President of Finance, effective July 29. Hamilton will be responsible for overseeing the ISO's financial management and its human resources and information technology departments.

Hamilton has had extensive experience as a financial executive, most recently as Corporate Treasurer and Corporate Director of Finance with Redcats USA, the largest specialty multi-channel retailer of value-priced apparel and merchandise in the U.S. Prior to his tenure at Redcats, Hamilton served in various senior-level finance positions for Auto Source, Inc., the worldwide headquarters for Kentucky Fried Chicken and H. J. Wilson Co., Inc.

In Indianapolis, Hamilton's commitment to the performing arts community is evident through his leadership work on the boards for the Phoenix Theatre (Treasurer), Dance Kaleidoscope and Storytelling Arts of Indiana (President). He earned a bachelor's in accounting at the University of Kentucky and is a Certified Treasury Professional (CTP) and a Certified Public Accountant (CPA).
