 - Listed below are three ways to make a gift of stock to the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra. Please see instructions below for the manner in which you want to handle the transaction.

1. Direct Transfer from your broker to our broker (DTC Transfer)
 - a) Notify Tom McTamney, Gift Processing Associate, at the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra at 317-229-7077.
 - b) Provide the following information to your broker in order to transfer the stock to Raymond James.

 2. Stock Certificate
 - a) When the certificate is in the name of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, please place in an envelope and deliver the *unsigned* stock certificate to Tom McTamney, Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, 32 E. Washington Street, Suite 600, Indianapolis, IN 46204-2919. If the certificate is in someone else's name, please contact Tom McTamney at 317-229-7077 for instructions.
 - b) We will deliver the stock certificate and an Irrevocable Stock Power to Raymond James & Associates, Inc. who will sell the stock and issue a check to the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra.
 - c) Your gift will be valued the day that your stock is received at the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra Office, or received in the ISO's Raymond James account.
 3. You have an account at Raymond James & Associates, Inc.
