Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra returns to Greater Greenwood area for three performances in 2016

INDIANAPOLIS – The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra returns to the Greater Greenwood area next year with three performances, as part of its new Duke Energy *317 Series*. The ISO will be performing on **Feb. 7** at Center Grove High School, **March 10** at the Mount Pleasant Christian Church, and **July 7** at Mallow Run Winery.

In its second season, the ISO's *317 Series* in Greenwood includes concerts featuring classical masterworks, special events and music education programs for students. The *317 Series* is sponsored by Duke Energy and funded The Margot L. and Robert S. Eccles Fund, a fund of CICF, and The Elba L. and Gene Portteus Branigin Foundation.
