Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra announces classical series at the Palladium for 2015-2016

Subscriptions now on sale for six classical concerts in the Carmel venue, which include Handel's Messiah, renowned pianists André Watts and Menahem Pressler, and three performances conducted by ISO Music Director Krzysztof Urbański

INDIANAPOLIS—The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra announced today its *Palladium Series* of six classical concerts at the Palladium at the Center for the Performing Arts for the 2015-2016 season, beginning with Handel's *Messiah* on Dec. 13. Subscriptions are on sale now; single tickets will go on sale Monday, Aug. 10.

The ISO's acclaimed Music Director Krzysztof Urbański returns to the Palladium for three of the six performances: Beethoven's Fifth and *The Rite of Spring* on Jan. 24; Rachmaninoff's Second Piano Concerto with Philippe Bianconi on March 6; and the series' closer with pianist Garrick Ohlsson on June 5. The *Palladium Series* schedule rounds out with legendary pianists André Watts (Apr. 17) and Menahem Pressler (May 8).

"We are excited to continue to showcase the ISO at the Center for the Performing Arts," said Gary Ginstling, Chief Executive Officer of the ISO. "With so many renowned conductors and soloists and masterworks by Mozart, Beethoven, Tchaikovsky and Rachmaninoff, next season's lineup is even more exciting."
